PROPOSED BY: Southern Texas, Northern Texas and Sun Country Sections

SUBJECT: Eligibility for the Life Member-Active Classification

This applies to the Life Member-Active classification only, does not affect Life Member-Retired eligibility, and would not be applied retroactively.

Entrance Education would be defined as the training and examination requirements as prescribed by the Board of Directors. This includes completion of the PGA Professional Golf Management Program in its entirety, or the Reciprocity Test-out Process allowed for certain Members of other PGA Recognized Professional Golf Associations, such as, but not limited to the LPGA, PGA of Canada, PGA of Great Britain, and to current or former PGA of America A-3 Members who have earned at least 30 credits. The Reciprocity Test-out options requires the purchase of Qualifying Level, Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 online access, as well as successfully completing the examination for the Qualifying Level, Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3, each separately.

Members who are no longer eligible for an Active Classification of Membership are eligible for a Non-Active Classification, one of which is Life Member-Active. The Life Member-Active Classification allows the rights and privileges of Active Classifications, and requires fulfilling the requirements of the Professional Development Program (MSR). For the majority of Members in this classification, participating in the Professional Development Program is a continuation of their career long development in the golf profession starting with completion of the entrance education requirements. For a few transferring Members, the obligation to complete Professional Development Program requirement is their first experience within PGA Education.
